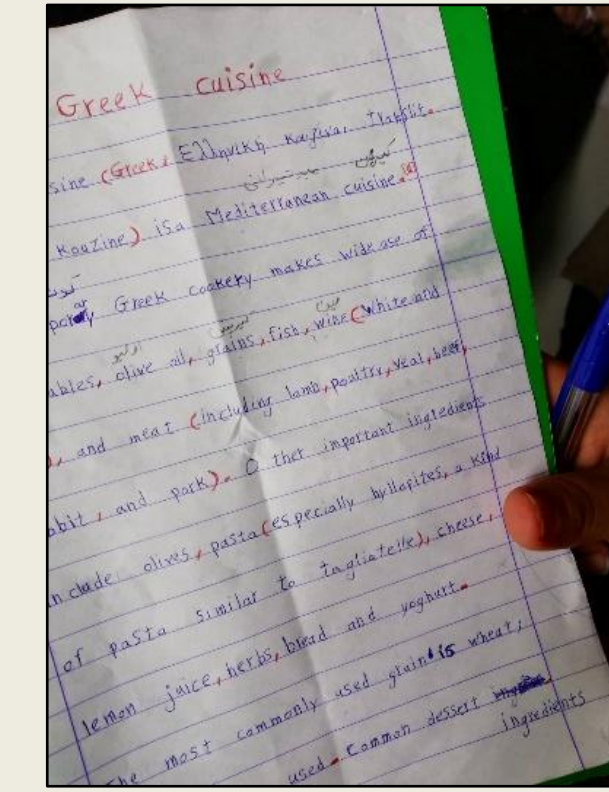


Non-Formal Education for Refugees

- ✓ A non-formal evaluation is conducted daily by the staff in the field (CwC meetings, attendance and performance of students)

- ✓ Bachelor's Degree (Greek & English Language and Literature, Preschool Education)
- ✓ Master in Education/Social Sciences
- ✓ Certifications in Special Education and Teaching Greek as a Second Language

9. PROBLEMS/CHALLENGES

- ✓ Frequent change of population
- ✓ Different backgrounds and levels of the learners along with psychosocial needs and traumas they have suffered
- ✓ Conditions at the site (weather, power etc.)

10. PROSPECTS

- ✓ Young learners feel more comfortable and achieve easier their goals in the formal education system
- ✓ Older learners become more fluent and can easily handle basic communication in English and Greek, to deal with everyday life needs
- ✓ Inclusion in the local community
